Terlaje father-son duo win GCC golf tourney

For the second year in a row, a father-son team has taken top honors at the GCC Foundation Par Excellence Golf Tournament. A scorecard playoff propelled Dr. Ricardo Terlaje and his son Eduardo to first place in the annual tournament, which helps to provide scholarships for GCC students. Dr. Terlaje and 12-year-old Eduardo, a student at Bishop Baumgartner School, netted 68.8 on the links at LeoPalace Resort on Saturday, as did the second place team of Logan Reyes and Zeb Hauser. Having shot a 4 on the 18th hole, though, put the father-son duo ahead.

“He’s been playing golf with me for about a year and a half now,” Dr. Terlaje said of Eduardo. “He wants to play for F.D. (Father Duenas Memorial School).”

Last year, the father-son team of Dr. Robert and Stephen Gatewood won the GCC tournament.

Rounding out the top three teams this year were Jose Perez and Eddie Castro, who shot a 69 overall. Taking the wild card slot was the team of Rafael Battung and Zaldy Torres.

The annual GCC Foundation Par Excellence golf tournament raises funds for \$1,000 scholarships for ten Guam Community College students and for CIP projects on the GCC campus. The scholarship recipients assisted at the tournament on Saturday.
