7. English & Math Placement [25] Options at GCC

Option A: Take the English & Math Placement Test at GCC

- Placement testing is a non-refundable \$22 fee. Payment is made at the cashier's office.
- Schedule [23] a meeting with a GCC counselor before making payment.

Option B: <u>CLYMER</u> [26] Program

 Recent high school graduates may qualify to bypass placement tests through the CLYMER Program. Click <u>HERE</u> [27] to learn more.

Option C: Placement with WorkKeys Certificate

- Guam Community College recognizes Gold and Platinum WorkKeys Certificates (awarded within the last two years) for enrollment in MA110A and/or EN110, instead of taking a placement exam.
