

University of the Philippines Alumni - Guam (UPAG) Scholarship at Guam Community College, 2025-2026

The University of the Philippines Alumni - Guam (UPAG) is a non-profit, non-partisan association established in Guam. It sponsors two (2) \$1,000.00 scholarships for undergraduate students at Guam Community College every year, subject to the availability of funds. For the academic year 2025-2026, UPAG is announcing the availability of two (2) scholarships (\$1,000.00 each). The scholarship is not limited to a particular discipline or course.

Eligible Scholarship Recipients. All scholarship applicants must meet the following:

1. The applicant must be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident of Guam.
2. The applicant must be enrolled full-time (at least 12 credits) at Guam Community College and must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or higher at the time of application. Full-time status must be maintained for all semesters covered by the scholarship.
3. The applicant must be in financial need.
4. The applicant must be of good moral character and must have no criminal record.
5. The scholarship recipient must attend at least one community event identified by the organization or one meeting of the University of the Philippines Alumni - Guam during the year covered by the scholarship.
6. Finalists selected from the applicant pool should be available for a 5-10 minute Zoom interview for the final stage of the selection of scholarship awardees, if the UPAG Scholarship Committee decides it is necessary.

Amount of Scholarship. The amount of the scholarship will be \$500 per semester, renewable every semester up to two years (maximum award - \$2,000), subject to the UPAG Scholarship Committee's review of the awardee's GPA and other criteria.

Application Guidelines.

1. Complete online application on the GCC Financial Aid Office website (<https://guamcc.edu/scholarships>) and submit no later than 5:00 pm, August 8, 2025. *Late submissions will not be accepted.*
2. Submit (a) transcript of records including grades for the Spring 2025 semester and (b) FAFSA Submission Summary for 2024-2025.
3. Finalists will be contacted by email and/or phone and scheduled for a 5-10 minute Zoom interview to determine final selection of scholarship awardees, as needed. *Please ensure that a working email address and phone number are provided in the application form.*
4. The applicant's sex, race, ethnic group, or religion plays no factor in the selection of the recipient.
