STEP 1

Go to <u>fafsa.gov</u> to complete your 2021-2022 FAFSA online. If you are a dependent student, a parent will also need to create an FSA ID to electronically sign your FAFSA. You will need to refer to financial/income tax information for the 2019 tax year.

- Include Guam Community College Federal School Code 015361 for our institution to receive your information electronically.
- Follow-up by emailing the GCC Financial Aid Office at <u>financialaid@guamcc.edu</u> ONE WEEK after submitting your FAFSA online.

STEP 2

Follow-Up with the GCC Financial Aid Office

- The GCC Financial Aid Office is REQUIRED to do verification and REQUEST for you to submit the <u>2021-2022 VERIFICATION WORKSHEET</u>; 2019 TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPT(s)-(<u>Request from Dept. of</u> <u>Revenue & Tax by submitting Form 4506-T</u>); 2019 W-2(s); AMENDED TAX RETURN; certification of SNAP benefits paid any time during 2019/2020.
- Continuing/returning students should check your GCC email and Financial Aid Requirements/Awards on MyGCC for any updates.
- New students will need to first apply for <u>admission</u> to GCC to receive financial aid updates.
- Your FAFSA must be complete and ALL required documents submitted before the PRIORITY DATES ABOVE. Otherwise, YOU MAY HAVE TO RELY ON YOUR OWN RESOURCES to pay for tuition, registration fees, books, supplies and other expenses.

STEP 3

Complete the <u>APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION AS A</u> <u>DECLARED STUDENT</u> form online. Submit your official high school or G.E.D. transcript to the Admissions & Registration Office. For more information, email <u>gcc.registrar@guamcc.edu</u> or contact (671) 735-5531/2/3.

- You must be accepted into Guam Community College seeking a degree or certificate program approved for Title IV funding by the U.S. Department of Education.
- Financial aid assistance will not cover credit hours/ course work which will not count towards the completion of student's degree program requirements.

STEP 4

Students whose FAFSA is complete AND ALL documents have been submitted AND have registered for classes will be emailed a DEFERMENT LETTER to there GCC email address. Deferment Letters must be obtained <u>before the payment</u> <u>deadline</u> for each semester.

- The Deferment Letter is to obtain your student ID and/ or book(s) at the GCC Bookstore.
- Pell Grant award is disbursed following certification of enrollment and satisfactory academic progress. Login to **MyGCC** at <u>guamcc.edu</u> to view your account and financial aid information and if a Net PELL Award check is available for pick-up at the Cashier's Office.
