### **Practical Nursing**

- The Associate of Science in Practical Nursing program received initial approval for the program effective on July 26<sup>th</sup> 2019.

# PRACTICAL NURSING

## **CNA/EMT**

- On Oct. 23, 2019, eight Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) students from Fall 2019 did 50 hours of clinical at Guam Regional Medical City (GRMC) as well as taking the GRMC's All Scripts Training.
- On Dec. 20-21, 2019, two CNA students from Fall 2019 took their CNA exams with the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners (GBNE) and awaiting results.
- Five CNA students from Spring 2019 who took the CNA exam on Sept. 20-21 passed and are now licensed CNA.

- One CNA student from Fall 2018 who took the CNA practical exam (retake) on Sept. 21, passed their exam and is now a licensed CNA.
- A Bi-Annual Report was submitted to GBNE on Dec. 31, 2019.
- Thirteen students completed the EMT course this past semester. They participated in clinicals at Guam Memorial Hospital's ER unit and Labor & Delivery Unit in October and also completed ten hours of ride along with the Guam Fire Department.
